husband recently purchased a townhouse in River
North; and she's already got her favorite spots pegged.

What made you choose River North when buying a home?

PAMELLA ROLAND DEVOS: I love River North. It's close to everything and my daughter also lives there. We often bring our dogs to the local dog park; they love running around together, and it offers a perfect opportunity to catch up.

Before buying a home, did you have a go-to hotel for trips to the city?

PRD: [My husband Dan and I] love The Peninsula Hotel (108 E. Superior St., 312-337-2888). It was our home away from home before we purchased our place in River North. You just can't beat the staff, amenities, and central location.

Where is your favorite spot to dine? Any must-have menu items?

PRD: My favorite spot for lunch is Fred's at Barneys New York (15 E. Oak St., 312-596-1111). Their pizza is a must-have! For dinner, one of our favorite restaurants is Japonais (600 W. Chicago Ave., 312-822-9600), especially since it's within walking distance from our townhouse. Our favorite appetizer is The Rock, thinly sliced marinated New York strip, cooked on a hot rock. The Bar at The Peninsula Hotel (312-573-6766) is a great place to unwind after dinner. I love the vibe and they have a great scene for people watching. Being a fashion designer, it's always fun and inspiring to see what everyone is wearing.

On that note, how do you view Chicago women in terms of style?

PRD: Chicago women really inspire me with their great sense of style. Because we have all four seasons in Chicago, [you] see women in beautiful coats on the first chilly day of fall and then—when spring breaks—there is such an amazing array of colors and prints.

Of course you don your own label, but where else do you like to shop?

PRD: You can always find me at Saks Fifth Avenue (700 N. Michigan Ave., 312-799-5211) or Neiman Marcus (737 N. Michigan Ave., 312-642-5900), either shopping or checking in on my collection. It's such a bonus when I get to meet my customers or chat with the sales associates; their feedback is so valuable. For home wares, Material Possessions (704 N. Wabash Ave., 312-280-4885) is one of my favorite destinations. They have so many beautiful and unique pieces. It's hard to leave the store empty-handed.

Any other Chicago favorites?

PRD: I really love the Joffrey Ballet and joined the board a few years ago. They are a great group of people and of course the performances are first class. This past year, pamella roland was part of the Joffrey's annual Couture & Cocktails event. We held a fashion show, which included a fun party—[it] was an overwhelming success.
